A: I have only a vague idea of what you're attempting to achieve but from the non-json output, it seems as if you just want to combine the existing file name and the date in the name... The best approach to do that in Python would be to create a dict where the key is the file name and the value is the date to be used with the file name. Then you iterate over the list outputting your list of dicts.
